Motor Vehicles. To apply for a Certificate of Title upon, and endorse and transfer title
thereto, for any automobile, truck, pickup truck, van, motorcycle, or other motor vehicle, and to
represent in such transfer or assignment that the title to said motor vehicle is free and clear of
all liens and encumbrances except those specifically set forth in such transfer or assignment;
Tax Powers. To act without limitation on my behalf with regard to federal income taxes
(Forms 1040, 1040EZ, 1040X, etc.), state and local income taxes, estate, gift (Form 709) and
other tax returns of all sorts, whether federal or state and local, including where appropriate joint
returns, FICA returns, payroll tax returns, claims for refunds, requests for extensions of time to
file returns or pay taxes, extensions and waivers of applicable periods of limitation, protests and
petitions to administrative agencies or courts, including the tax court, regarding tax matters, and
